We have just had the pleasure of working with College Works Painting and wanted to detail how pleased we were with their work.


We recently found it necessary to have a large amount of 4 Board Paddock Fence repainted. We noticed a College Works Painting sign on one of my neighbor's properties and shortly thereafter found one of their flyers in my newspaper holder and decided to give them a call. I spoke directly to Owen Thomas their local Student Manager. He was very professional in explaining the mission of College Works Painting and their operation. We requested that he stop by and give us an estimate for the work we wanted done.

We set up an appointment and Owen showed up exactly when he promised he would. He once again explained the College Work Painting Program and the various options available to us. We told him that we wanted to use our own special oil based fence paint and he said that it wouldn't be a problem. He then made a thorough inspection of the fencing that we wanted painted and presented us with a detailed written estimate and a time frame in which he could perform the work. The estimate went so far as to give us a price with and without our paint which we thought was very useful. He also explained that there was a 10% discount if we signed when the estimate was presented. In that we had already decided to have the fence painted and his estimate appeared reasonable we decided to accept his proposal and signed the contract.

Initially Owen said that he could start the job in 2-3 weeks, however we were pleasantly surprised when we received his call a couple of days later explaining that he had hired a new crew and he could have them start in a couple of days. We were very pleased and gave him the go ahead. His college student painting crew, Thad Pastore and Jake Toulouse, arrived on time and went right to work. Owen had briefed them on what had to be done leaving me little to explain before they started. Thad, Jake and Gary Marean who later joined their crew, were very conscientious, polite, hard working and a pleasure to work with during their 5 days on the job. Their job was not exactly an easy one having done the same thing myself over the years. They did everything we asked without question, took a minimum of breaks and did a superb job. The fence looks like it has just been erected and not the 20 years that it has been up.

Throughout the process Owen stopped by 2-3 time a day to check on his crew and the progress they were making and to see if we were pleased with the work that had been done to date. Suffice to say we were extremely please with College Works Painting and their college based program and more specifically Owen and his crew.
